Purpose of this Request for Quotes

Fondazzjoni Sagħtar is seeking the services **for the Research of a Children's Book** entitled 'Vjolenza Qatt u ma' Hadd' which is planned to be published in the coming months.

1. Introduction

Fondazzjoni Sagħtar is an independent and autonomous voluntary organisation, without any political affiliation, founded with the main purpose of serving a social and educational function among Maltese and Gozitan educators and students.

The Commission on Gender-Based Violence and Domestic Violence has granted funding for the Project 'Vjolenza Qatt u ma' Hadd/Violence? Never, against Whoever' following *Fondazzjoni Sagħtar*'s application through the Together We Empower Programme.

Part of the project entails the design and publishing of a book mainly targeted at primary school students. The children's book is set to consist of 32 pages (excluding cover).

2. Services Required

Conditions and specifications for REQUEST FOR QUOTATION for the Research of a Children's Book being published by *Fondazzjoni Sagħtar*:

There are limited publications used in schools that specifically tackle the issues of gender-based violence and domestic violence. The book shall be a 32-page publication to be distributed among primary school students in the last year of primary. The themes/situations, ca 25, shall be gender-based violence and domestic violence, adapted for the age groups of students. The book shall be illustrated and designed through separate quotes being issued. The services requested include the research of the theme which will be the basis of the text of the book.

Furthermore, limited publications exist which are written in both Maltese and English, for maximum reachability and accessibility.
